1. SECRET - ENTIRE TEXT.

2. [REDACTED] TOLD THE AMBASSADOR MARCH 8 THAT HE HAD INFORMATION THAT DISTURBED HIM. THIS WAS THAT NORTH KOREAN FOREIGN MINISTER, KIM YONG-HAM (ALSO DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER), HAD TOLD TANZANIAN OFFICIALS DURING HIS FEBRUARY 21-23 VISIT HERE THAT "NOW THAT THE U. S. S. R. NO LONGER PROVIDED NUCLEAR SECURITY, THE DPRK WAS GOING AHEAD WITH A PROGRAM TO ACQUIRE ITS OWN NUCLEAR WEAPONS."

3. [REDACTED] SAID HE KNEW THAT THE DPRK HAD A PROGRAM TO DEVELOP NUCLEAR WEAPONS BUT THAT KIM'S STATEMENT, IF TRUE, IS A NEW DEPARTURE WHICH WAS CAUSE FOR CONCERN. HE ASKED IF THE EMBASSY COULD CORROBORATE KIM'S REMARKS THROUGH OUR SOURCES. THE AMBASSADOR AGREED TO TRY TO DO SO.
